We ask that you please file your I8OO as soon as possible and then send an email confirmation to your IAS including your tracking number to confirm that you have filed for immigration.

When approved, you will receive what is called the I-8OO provisional approval letter through mail, and an NVC letter through email. Once received, you will need to send these to your IAS so the country can apply for the DS-26O to begin your child's visa process.
